STANDARD OF CARE

Keeping your puppies & dogs up to date on their health is important to their overall well-being. Our goal is to keep your pets happy and healthy. If you have any questions, ask the vet!

ADULT DOGS

- Physical exam every 6-12 months
- Annual comprehensive blood and urine early detection screening
- Annual heartworm & tick born disease screening
- Annual intestinal parasite screening
- Core vaccinations-DHPP, Rabies, Leptospirosis
- Lifestyle vaccinations-Bordetella, Canine Influenza, Lyme
- Year-round heartworm/flea/tick prevention
- Annual dental screening

PUPPIES

FIRST VISIT

- DHPP
- Intestinal parasite screening
- Deworming
- First heartworm/flea/tick prevention then every month after that

SECOND VISIT

- DHPP
- Bordetella
- Leptospirosis
- Intestinal parasite screening
- Deworming

THIRD VISIT

- DHPP
- Leptospirosis
- Rabies
- +/- lifestyle vaccines (*canine influenza and lyme*)

FOURTH VISIT

- DHPP
- +/-lifestyle vaccines (*canine influenza and lyme*)

Small breed dogs: spay/neuter anytime after 5-6 months old and prior to first heat cycle

Large breed dogs: spay/neuter closer to 8-12 months old

Giant breed dogs: spay/neuter between 12-24 month old
